

POST-FIRST WORLD WAR TREATIES, 1919 - 1923

TIMELINE

1918

8th January - Woodrow Wilson's '14 Points' speech (p.19)

3rd March - Treaty of Brest-Litovsk signed between Germany and Russia (p.28)

11th November - Armistice signed (p.14)

14th December - David Lloyd George won the 'Coupon Election' in Britain after promising to 'make Germany pay' (p.22)

1919

18th January - The Paris Peace Conference began (p.15)

28th June - The Treaty of Versailles signed with Germany (p.23)

12th July - Blockade on Germany lifted (p.29)

10th September - Treaty of St Germain signed with Austria (p.31)

27th November - Treaty of Neuilly signed with Bulgaria (p.32)

1920

21st January - End of Paris Peace Conference (p.15)

4th June - Treaty of Trianon signed with Hungary (p.33)

10th August - Treaty of Sevres signed with the Ottoman Empire (p.33)

1921

January - German reparations set at £6.6 billion (p.24)

1922

4th October - Financial reconstruction of Austria agreed (p.36)

November - Germany defaulted on reparations payment (p.29)

1923

11th January - French invasion of the Ruhr (p.29)

24th July - Treaty of Lausanne signed with Turkey (p.34)

29th October - Republic of Turkey declared (p.34)

November - Because of hyperinflation, a loaf of bread cost 200,000 million German marks (p.29)

1924

14th March - Financial reconstruction of Hungary agreed (p.36)
